

Currency Com US LLC Privacy Policy

Last Updated: November 10, 2021

This Privacy Policy explains how information about you is collected, used and disclosed by Currency Com US LLC and its affiliated companies (“**Currency Com**”). This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect when you use our website and mobile application (collectively, the “**Services**”) or when you otherwise interact with us.

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make changes, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of the policy and, in some cases, we may provide you with additional notice (such as adding a statement to our website or sending you a notification). We encourage you to review the Privacy Policy whenever you access the Services or otherwise interact with us to stay informed about our information practices and the ways you can help protect your privacy.

1. Collection of Information

1.1 Information You Provide to Us

We collect information you provide directly to us. For example, we collect information when you create an account, deposit and withdraw funds, place an order, apply for a job, request customer support, communicate with us via third party social media sites, or otherwise communicate with us. The types of information we may collect include basic user information (such as name and email address), taxpayer identification (such as your social security number), financial information (such as your bank account details and your credit card number, expiration date and security code) and any other information we may require or which you may choose to provide.

1.2 Information We Collect Automatically When You Use the Services

When you access or use our Services, we automatically collect information about you, including:

- **Log Information:** We collect log information about your use of the Services, including the type of browser you use, access times, pages viewed, your IP address and the page you visited before navigating to our Services.
- **Device Information:** We collect information about the computer or mobile device you use to access our Services, including the hardware model, operating system and version, unique device identifiers and mobile network information.
- **Information Collected by Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies:** We and our service providers use various technologies to collect information, including cookies and web beacons. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive or in device memory that help us improve our Services and your experience, see which areas and features of our Services are popular and

count visits. Web beacons are electronic images that may be used in our Services or emails and help deliver cookies, count visits and understand usage and campaign effectiveness. For more information about cookies, and how to disable them, please see "Your Choices" in Section [7](#) below.

1.3 Information We Collect from Other Sources

We may also obtain information from other sources and combine that with information we collect through our Services. For example, we may collect information about you from third parties, including but not limited to identity verification services, credit bureaus, mailing list providers and publicly available sources.

2. Use of Information

We may use information about you for various purposes, including to:

- Provide, maintain and improve our Services;
- Provide and deliver the products and services you request, process transactions and send you related information, including confirmations and receipts,
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts and support and administrative messages;
- Respond to your comments, questions and requests and provide customer service;
- Communicate with you about products, services, offers, promotions, rewards, and events offered by Currency Com and others, and provide news and information we think will be of interest to you;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage and activities in connection with our Services;
- Detect, investigate and prevent fraudulent transactions and other illegal activities and protect the rights and property of Currency Com and others;
- Personalize and improve the Services and provide advertisements, content or features that match user profiles or interests;
- Facilitate contests, sweepstakes and promotions and process and deliver entries and rewards;
- Link or combine with information we get from others to help understand your needs and provide you with better service; and
- Carry out any other purpose for which the information was collected.

3. Sharing of Information

We may share information about you as follows or as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy:

- With vendors, consultants and other service providers who need access to such information to carry out work on our behalf;
- In response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with, or required by, any applicable law, regulation or legal process;
- If we believe your actions are inconsistent with our user agreements or policies, or to protect the rights, property and safety of Currency Com or others;
- In connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by another company;
- Between and among Currency Com and its current and future parents, affiliates, subsidiaries and other companies under common control and ownership; and
- With your consent or at your direction.

We may also share aggregated, pseudo-anonymous or de-identified information, which cannot reasonably be used to identify you.

4. Advertising and Analytics Services Provided by Others

We may allow others to provide analytics services and serve advertisements on our behalf across the Internet and in applications. These entities may use cookies, web beacons, device identifiers and other technologies to collect information about your use of the Services and other websites and applications, including your IP address, web browser, mobile network information, pages viewed, time spent on pages or in apps, links clicked and conversion information. This information may be used by Currency Com and others to, among other things, analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content, deliver advertising and content targeted to your interests on our Services and other websites and better understand your online activity.

5. Security

Currency Com takes reasonable measures to help protect information about you from loss, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

6. Transfer of Information to the U.S. and Other Countries

Currency Com is based in the United States and the information we collect is governed by U.S. law. By accessing or using the Services or otherwise providing information to us, you consent to the processing, transfer and storage of information in and to the U.S. and other countries, where you may not have the same rights and protections as you do under local law.

7. Your Choices

7.1 Account Information

You may update, correct or delete information about you at any time by logging into your online account or by emailing us at crypto@currency.com. If you wish to delete or deactivate your account, please email us at crypto@currency.com, but note that we may retain certain information as required by law or for legitimate business purposes. We may also retain cached or archived copies of information about you for a certain period of time.

7.2 Cookies

Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default. If you prefer, you can usually choose to set your browser to remove or reject browser cookies. Please note that if you choose to remove or reject cookies, this could affect the availability and functionality of our Services.

7.3 Promotional Communications

You may opt out of receiving promotional emails or text messages from Currency Com by following the instructions in those emails or text messages. If you opt out, we may still send you non-promotional communications, such as those about your account or our ongoing business relations.

7.4 Mobile Push Notifications/Alerts

With your consent, we may send promotional and non-promotional push notifications or alerts to your mobile device. You can deactivate these messages at any time by changing the notification settings on your mobile device.

Privacy Policy for California Residents

Beginning January 1, 2020, the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”) gives California residents certain rights with respect to the processing of personal data (known as “personal information” under the CCPA).

9. Collection of Information

Section 1 of our Privacy Policy sets forth the categories of personal information that currency.com collects and processes about you, a description of each category, and the sources from which we obtain each category. Section 2 describes how we use your personal information, and Section 3 describes our sharing practices.

10. Your Rights

10.1 Right to Know

Under the CCPA, you have a right to request information about our collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information over the prior 12 months, and request that we provide you with the following information:

1. Categories of and specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you.
2. Categories of sources from which we collect personal information.
3. Purposes for collecting personal information.
4. Categories of third parties with whom we share personal information.
5. Categories of personal information disclosed about you for a business purpose.
6. If applicable, categories of personal information sold about you and the categories of third parties to which the personal information was sold, by category or categories of personal information for each third party to which the personal information was sold.

10.2 Right to Delete

You also have a right to request that we delete personal information, subject to certain limitations under applicable law.

10.3 Right to Opt-out From Sale

You may request to opt-out of any “sale” of your personal information that may take place. We do not rent or sell personal information and take care to not enter into any data sharing arrangements that could constitute a "sale" under the CCPA.

11. Non-discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your rights under the CCPA.
